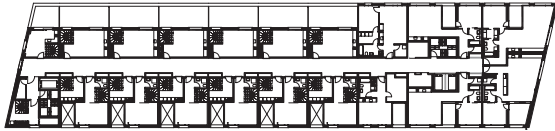
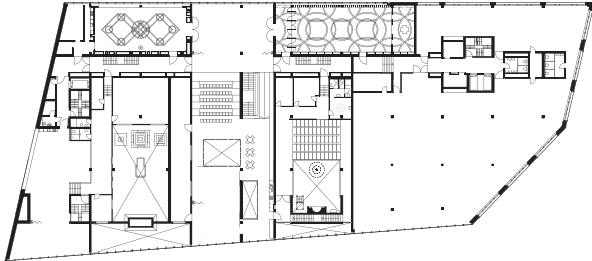


Europaplatz Multipurpose Center | House of Religions Bern

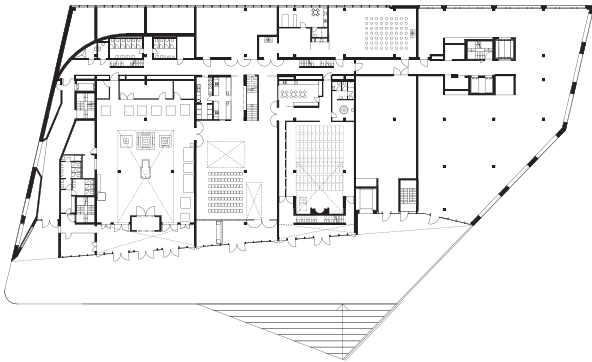

In addition to the 88 apartments located in the building, there are flexible administrative areas, various shops, dining establishments and most importantly - in the heart of building - the House of Religions. 8 world religions live and pray together. 5 religious group have a private prayer area. All this is held together by a common element, the dialog area where people of different cultures meet, discuss, and celebrate together.



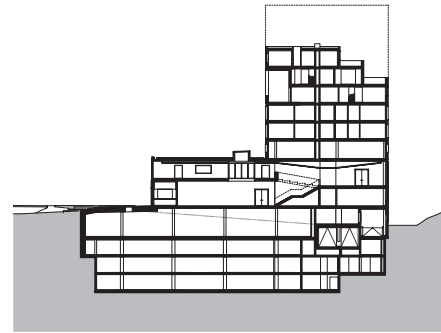

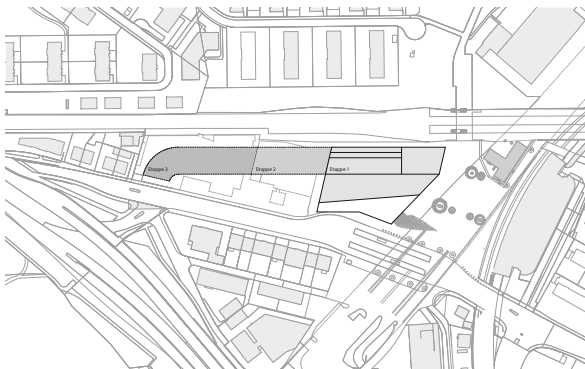
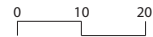
Plan +2 House of Religions
